**NATIONAL RESPONSE CORPORATION DELIVERS DONATED SUPPLIES AND  
ASSISTS IN REPAIR EFFORT AT HAITI'S TERMINAL VARREUX**

Port-au-Prince, HAITI  
January 28, 2010

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE - National Response Corporation (NRC) announced today that the *NRC Perseverance*, a 110-foot oil spill response vessel, arrived yesterday in Haiti with relief supplies donated in the vessel's home port at St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands. More than 10 tons of provisions, including water, medical supplies, food and personal hygiene products were collected in St. Croix by Hispanos Unidos and the Rotary Club of St. Croix West, and transferred to the *NRC Perseverance* with the cooperation of HOVENSA LLC. The donations will be distributed by the Haitian Red Cross in coordination with the Haitian Rotary Club and Haiti National Disaster groups.

The *NRC Perseverance*, a fully equipped emergency response vessel with a large deck and crew quarters, will serve as a command and communications platform for SEACOR Environmental Services (SES) emergency management personnel on the ground in Port-au-Prince. The vessel will assist SES with the restoration of Terminal Varreux, a marine fuel supply terminal in Port-au-Prince, owned by the WIN Group of Haiti. The terminal, which receives and stores in excess of 70% of Haiti's fuel oil, suffered infrastructure damage during the earthquake. SES is working with the WIN Group to restore marine and storage tank operations at the terminal in order to supply Haiti with critically needed fuel.

The *NRC Perseverance* is one of two oil spill response vessels NRC maintains in a standby status at the HOVENSA refinery in St. Croix as part of HOVENSA's oil spill response program. "We are in a unique position to assist in the Haitian relief efforts given our vessels' capabilities and close proximity to Haiti," said Steve Candito, president of NRC. "We truly appreciate the support and cooperation offered by HOVENSA as well as the local humanitarian groups both in St. Croix and in Haiti."
